Motion to set the **proposed 2025** levy was made by George E. Carlson and seconded by Patrick J. Gerold. Motion unanimous (3-0). The residents of the Township vote on the propose levy to set it at the Annual Meeting in March.

It was decided to increase the 2025 levy, because of the large increase in the Fire contracts, especially Braham's. It was not raised more due to the money received from the state and county is usually \$20,000.00 more than the levied amount.
