Business: Motion to accept the Regular meeting agenda was made by Robert A. Anderson and seconded by George E. Carlson. Motion unanimous (3-0).

The Road inspection date was set for Saturday, April 20, 2024. The board will meet at the Town hall at 8:00 AM.
